About the test:

The entrance test for admission to Master's Degree in Hospital Management is conducted by the Directorate of Admissions, Osmania University in Hyderabad on 04th July 2026 (tentatively). The Venue, date and time of examination will be indicated on HALL TICKET (Admit Card)

The test is of 1½ hours duration (90 minutes). It is assessed for 100 marks, each carrying 20 marks, as detailed below.

The qualifying mark in the entrance test for general and BC candidates is 25%.

Instructions to Candidates:

Along with the test booklet, a separate OMR answer sheet will be provided with question numbers 1-100. Each Question will have 4 alternative choices marked as A B C D with one correct/appropriate answer. Candidate has to choose that correct/appropriate answer and has to darken the relevant oval for that question on the OMR answer sheet with HB pencil. If any alteration is to be made, erase the previous one and darken the correct one. Answer with overwriting or wrong method of marking will be ignored while awarding marks.

Section – B: Numerical Ability – 20 Questions – 20 Marks

This section is designed to test the candidate's ability to work with numbers consisting of arithmetic, algebra, geometry and interpretation of tables and graphs of 10th class or SSC Standard.
